



UNIVERSITY OF VIGO CALL FOR COMPANIES TO JOIN THE EURES CROSSBORDER GALICIA NORTH OF PORTUGAL TRAINEESHIPS PROGRAMME.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this call is selecting companies and organizations located in the North Portugal region that can offer students suitable training plans and good conditions to perform academic internships.

The final aim of this selection will be making up a list of possible vacancies for a further call for 10 grants for students of any of the official graduate programmes offered by the University of Vigo.

2. REQUIREMENTS

Providing that their geographical proximity to the Campuses of the University of Vigo allows internships in a cross-border basis, any companies and organizations registered in Portugal whose work centres are located in any of the districts listed below are eligible:

- Viana do Castelo
- Braga
- Oporto
- Vila Real

To join this programme any companies or organizations should also meet the following criteria:

- Being legally established on Portuguese territory.
- Regarding the proposed training plan, having suitably qualified staff in order to supervise the learning progress of the students.

3. OBJECT:

- All the proposals meeting the requirements will make up the list of vacancies in a further call for 10 grants for students to perform external internships in these companies/entities.
The final selection of the beneficiary companies will be made directly by the students with the 10 best qualifications.
- The University of Vigo will bear all the economic costs and provide all the administrative services in relation with the grants and Social Security of students.
- Grants assigned to students, paid by the University of Vigo and charged to the budget as an activity of Eures-T, will sum up a total amount of 800€ plus Social Security costs per person.
- Internships will be compulsorily performed from 1 of July of 2017 to 31 of August of 2017 on a weekly 25-hour basis. When it is necessary to facilitate the cross-border nature of internships, 30% of these hours can be performed as a distance-training.



4. APPLICATIONS

Companies and organizations that are interested should fill in the application form available in the web site of the Employment and Entrepreneurship Area of the University of Vigo http://emplego.uvigo.es/emplego_gl/eures/practicas/.

This should be done before 14:00 of 20th may of 2017. (Spanish time).

Each company/organization can apply for a maximum of 3 students per work centre. A company/organization will only take more than one student if the total number of applications from companies is less than ten.

In their application form companies can also show their interest in joining other internship programmes, particularly Erasmus+.

5. MONITORING COMMITTEE

A committee will be set up to monitor this call. It will be made up of:

- The Vice-rector for students or her designee.
- The Vice-rector for International Relationships or his designee.
- Two internship coordinators coming from different areas of knowledge.
- A representative of EURES-T.

6. COMMITMENTS

Applying to this call implies a commitment to:

- Formalizing an educational cooperation agreement with the University of Vigo in order to perform external academic internships.
- Hosting a student selected by the University of Vigo during the months of July and August.
- Keep and complete the training plan included in Annex I.

RESOLUTION

The Vice-rector for Students, in accordance with the monitoring committee, will publish a list of selected companies that will eventually make up the list of vacancies in a further call for 10 grants for students.

The criteria applied in this further call for students, will be draft in such way that the global list of vacancies should cover all areas of knowledge in the following proportions:

1. Arts and Humanities – 1 vacancy



2. Health Sciences - 1 vacancy
3. Sciences - 2 vacancies
4. Legal and Social Sciences - 3 vacancies
5. Engineering - 3 vacancies
